PARTICULARS OF NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF SECONDARY STEEL TECHNOLOGY (NISST), FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

BACKGROUND

The need for Human Resource Development and Technology Upgradation in the secondary steel sector comprising mainly the steel melting units with EAF or IF, and the Re-rolling units has been felt since long. A similar opinion was expressed by the Advisory Committee on Steel Rolling Industries, set up by Ministry of Steel, Government of India in 1984. It was primarily based on these needs and also the demand from the industry, that the National Institute of Secondary Steel Technology was set up as a registered society on 18th August, 1987 under the Chairman of Development Commissioner for Iron & Steel.

The following areas of secondary steel sector are under the purview of the Institute:

- Electric Arc and Induction Furnace
- Ladle Refining
- Rolling Mills (Hot & Cold)
- Direct Reduced Iron units

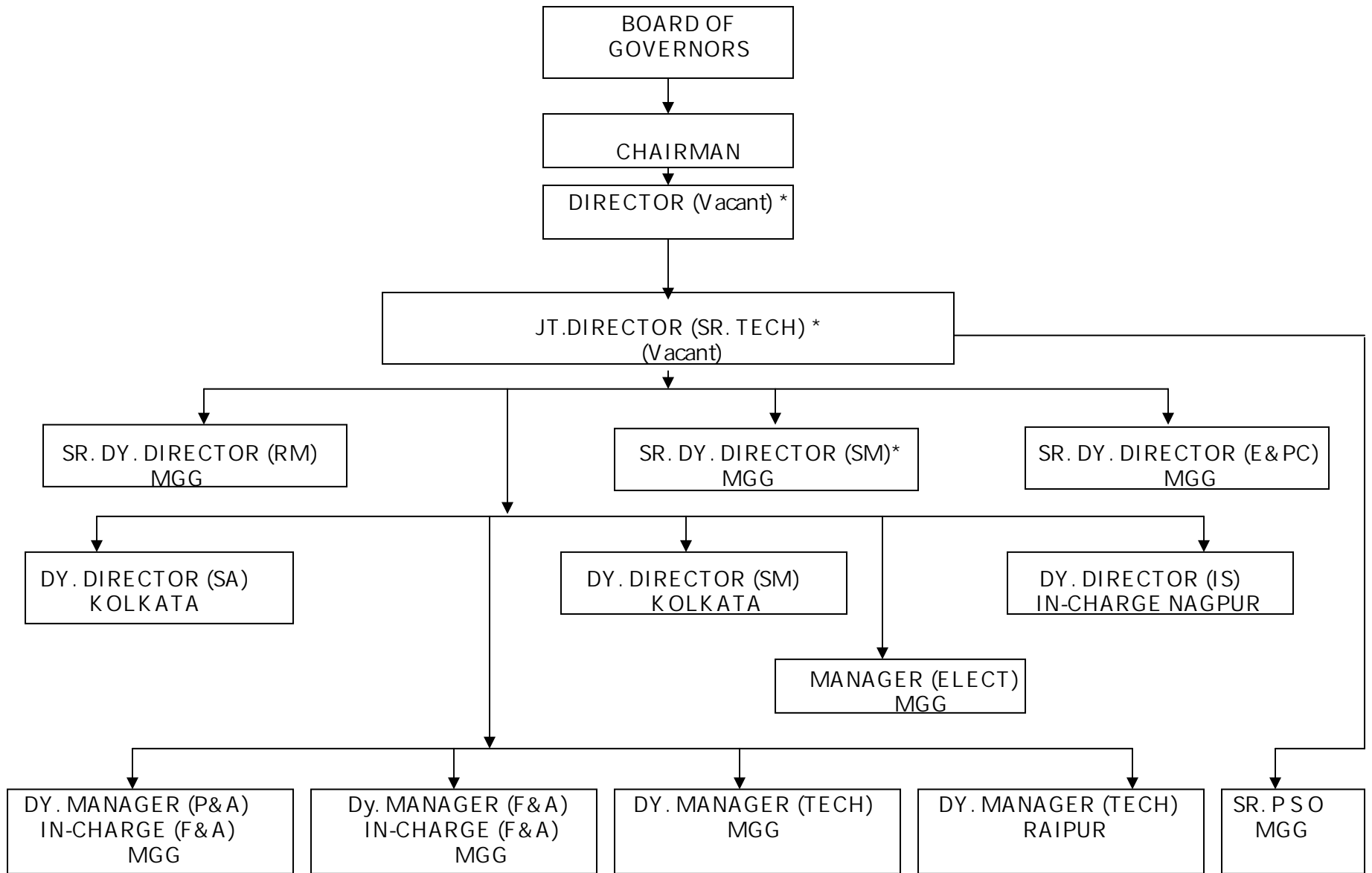
